

## **Spiritual Healing/Mediumship**

In the UK the Fraudulent Mediums Act of 1951 has been repealed since April 2008 by the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading 2007 (CPR's) which implement the Unfair Commercial Practices Directive (UCPD). The CPR's include rules prohibiting conduct which misleads the average consumer and thereby causes, or is likely to cause him, to take a transactional decision he would not have taken otherwise'. Conduct could be deemed unfair if it deceives the average member of (i) the group to which it is directed or (ii) a clearly identifiable group of consumers who are particularly vulnerable to this type of practice.

The original Act required proof that the medium or healer was fraudulent. The changes will mean that a complainant can say they believe the medium or healer was fraudulent and it will be up to the medium or healer to prove they weren't.
